

JBMR Plus Special Edition: Hypophosphataemic Bone Disorders: Call for Submissions

Do you have an interesting case or unpublished original research relating to patients with **hypophosphataemic bone disorders**? The ANZBMS is excited to announce a call for original research and case reports on hypophosphataemic bone disorders. This initiative is supported by an independent Medical Education Grant from Kyowa Kirin Australia.

This initiative by ANZBMS aims to encourage healthcare professionals, researchers, and experts in the field to provide their experience and expertise to disseminate high-quality research exploring various aspects of hypophosphataemic bone disorders (other than nutritional rickets) and its management, including but not limited to:

1. X-linked hypophosphataemia
2. Autosomal dominant hypophosphataemic rickets
3. Tumour-induced osteomalacia
4. Ferric carboxymaltose infusion induced hypophosphataemia
5. Other rare forms of hypophosphataemic bone disorders

This issue will be supported by the guest editors Prof Richard Prince, Prof Craig Munns, Dr Albert Kim and Dr Madhuni Herath.

Up to 10 authors will have the JBMR Plus publication charges waived via the Medical Education Grant from Kyowa Kirin. Selection of papers for submission to JBMR Plus will be based on evaluation of submitted abstracts (see submission guideline attached or the [ANZBMS Website](#)). All papers selected to proceed will be subject to peer-review through the JBMR Plus editorial System. ANZBMS members and non-members are eligible to submit abstracts.

Timeline:

- **Submission of abstract to ANZBMS ECIC (ecic@anzbms.org.au) by December 21st 2023**
- Successful authors informed: January 2024
- Submission of manuscripts by authors successful in Stage 1: April 21st 2024
